What is Title I?

- Title I is the largest federal aid program for our nation's schools.
- The goal of Title I is to provide a high-quality education for every child.
- Title I resources address the needs of all children in the school, particularly the needs of low-achieving students.

Goals of Title I

- Increase academic achievement for all students
- Requires that schools be accountable
- Requires that parents are provided assistance in understanding how well their school and their child is performing.

Title I Funds in the Public Schools

- Allocated on basis of number of students eligible for free/reduced lunch
- Title I ensures that students are provided with all instructional materials/supplies needed plus additional services
- Ensures academic interventions for all students
- Ensures opportunities for parent input and training

Parent's Right to Know

- Annual Title I meeting with input to the Title I plan
- Opportunities to meet regularly as Title I Parents
- Be informed of your child's progress and expectations.
- Provide input for the Parent Involvement policy and Parent School Compact, TSIP.
- When our school is in Program Improvement Status (We are in good standing with the state)


