



DRESS CODE

TOPS

Students are encouraged to wear Raleigh-Egypt Middle School t-shirts with any uniform bottom. They may also wear uniform tops with a collar, polo style or dress shirt. Uniform Tops must be Red, Black, White, or Gray.



Bottoms

Uniform Bottoms must be Pants or knee-length skirts. Bottoms should be Black, Khaki, Blue, or Gray.



All uniform clothing must be plain with no manufacturers' logos, insignias, brand names or pictures visible on the clothing.

Uniform Restrictions

- Light jackets, vests, shirts, sweaters, sweat shirts, and cardigans are permitted as items that may be worn over the uniform top. They must be white, tan, navy blue, black or one of the additional colors approved by the school leadership council.
- Students should not wear hoodies during the school day unless they contain an authorized REMS logo.
- Jogger pants and Jeans are not permitted. NO denim material (jean pants, jackets, skirts or jumpers) may be worn as uniform clothing.
- Walking shorts are permitted. (Walking shorts are straight-legged shorts that are **knee-length**.) Short shorts (mid-thigh or higher) are not permitted.
- Pants must fit at the waist and not be oversized or undersized. Baggy pants, sagging pants, tights/leggings, or pants made of spandex are prohibited. Pants/shorts should cover underwear.
- Skirts or jumpers must be at or below the knee. Miniskirts are not appropriate for school. Clothing must be suitable to allow participation in physical education activities.
- Appropriate undergarments must be worn.
- T-shirts must be solid white or black.
- High heels are not acceptable as they often cause safety problems. No “Flip-Flops” or house shoes are allowed. Tennis shoes are required for physical education. If sandals are worn, they must have a heel strap.
- Backpacks, Heavy coats, jackets and raincoats must be stored in lockers upon arrival at school.
- Head apparel (hoods, hats, scarves, bonnets, etc.) must not be worn inside the school building except for religious or medical reasons.

The following items are deemed UNSAFE and INAPPROPRIATE for ALL STUDENTS and they are NOT PERMITTED in school .

- Gang affiliated attire will not be permitted while on school property or at school-sponsored/sanctioned activities. This includes any type of clothing, apparel, accessory, or color that denotes the students' membership in or affiliation with any criminal gang.
- Alcohol, tobacco, or drug advertising will not be permitted.
- Rompers, halter tops, tank tops with string ties, exposed stomachs, net shirts, plunging necklines, and “see-through” tops are not acceptable.
- Large, long, or heavy chains, Studded or chained accessories, Drug, Weapon, or Gang Affiliated Jewelry
- Sleepwear, house shoes, blankets
- Mouth grills

Consequences for not Adhering to the Uniform Policy

Middle school students not in uniform are subject to receive administrative discipline. If a student comes to school wearing inappropriate clothing, the parent may be called to bring appropriate attire while the child waits in the ISS classroom or students may be issued an overnight suspension for a mandatory parent conference.

THE SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO DETERMINE WHETHER THE STUDENT’S ATTIRE IS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF DECENCY, MODESTY, AND SAFETY.
