Getting Online and on TEAMS

- Virtual learning will occur through Microsoft TEAMS.
- After students log in to their district device with their personal student username and password, they will click the TEAMS app and join their class meeting.
- Teachers have contacted their parents to explain how to access the TEAMS meeting. If you have not been contacted by your child's teacher, please contact the school.

The School Day

- The Grahamwood school day is from 8-3.
- Students learning at home will participate in virtual classes throughout the regularly scheduled school day. Independent work and physical activity will be built into the daily schedule.
- Students will NOT be expected to sit in front of their device for the whole 7 hours. Breaks will be incorporated throughout the school day. Students must, however, attend each class with their teacher.
- Students will receive a thirty-minute lunch break. Teachers will share their class schedules during today's virtual learning.

Your @Home School Space

- Create a "special" learning space for your child to do schoolwork. If there are multiple siblings, separate the workspaces to maximize privacy.
- Ensure that the workspace is clutter free and stocked with the necessary school supplies.
- Ensure that the workspace is quiet and free from distractions. Make a list of the things that distract your child. Then, find ways to limit them during learning time.
- Check to make sure your child's device is near an electrical outlet to keep the device powered.
- Ensure that seating is comfortable and there's plenty of lighting.

Parent Communication

- Teachers will communicate with parents through dojo at least weekly.
- In addition, teachers will call each parent bi-weekly to provide an update on academic progress. Where possible, the student should be present for this conversation also.
- Please request conference appointments via email. We ask that you not interrupt our teachers while they are teaching.

Staying Connected

Attendance & Absences

- Students are expected to be present for the entire school day.
- Attendance will be formally recorded in Powerschool.
- Attendance will be taken in each block (i.e. Reading, Math, Social Studies, Support).
- If your student is not present for the whole day, they will be coded as Tardy or as having an Early Check Out.
- Excessive absences will be flagged and turned over to the school guidance team, the district attendance TEAM, and the truancy office.
- In order to excuse your absence, please email a note to your child's homeroom teacher.

- Help make sure students get logged in by 8:15
- Set up a distraction-free workspace for their student
- Be on hand to assist with technology issues
- Give our students the "space" and time to work independently
