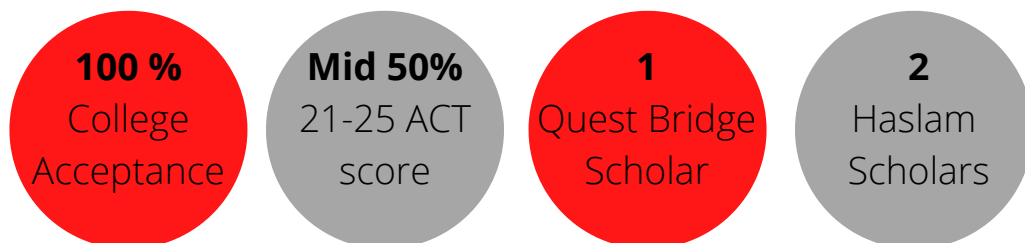
Honors, AP COURSES and DUAL ENROLLMENT
