IN THE CLASSROOM THIS WEEK

High Frequency words: fun, make, they, too

Phonics: short o

Phonics Pattern/Spelling Words: hop, top, log, hog, hot, lot

Grammar: questions & exclamations/ABC order

Reading: key details/visualize

Math: Topic 3, lessons 5-9

Homework (optional)

Mon: Change the middle vowel to o to make a new word:
hip, tap, hat, flip, black, cat, rib, jig, fix, rat
*count by 2s to 50, 5s to 100, 10s to 100

Tues: write the doubles +1 equation for each double fact:
1+1; 2+2; 3+3; 4+4; 5+5; 6+6; 7+7; 8+8; 9+9;
10+10 (ex. 2+2 would be 2+3)
*read a book

Wed: Write the spelling words in ABC order
*write all the partners of 10 (1+9, 2+8,...)

Thurs: write the number that is 1 more, 1 less, 10 more, and 10 less for each:
11, 35, 50, 15, 29
*write 2 questions and 2 exclamatory sentences

Things to Remember:
