Reading: key details/ask and answer questions

Math: topic 3 review, test Wednesday

Mon: Write spelling words in ABC order. Write a sentence for the words that come first and last.

Tues: create examples of fact families by writing 2 addition and 2 subtraction equations for each group of numbers: (4, 2, 6) (8, 1, 9) (5, 3, 2) (Ex: 1+2=3, 2+1=3, 3-1=2, 3-2=1)

*read a book

Wed.: Tell why each is not a complete sentence. Then use it to write a complete sentence.

1. naps in the sun.

2. a fish

3. jump on the bed.

*count by 2s to 50

Thurs.: practice counting backward, starting and stopping with the following: 54...48; 60...55; 21...17; 103...98

*read a book
