Uniform Policy:

Pants – black, navy blue or khaki / No skin showing/ No stretch pants, No Yoga pants/tights, No overalls, short shorts / No sagging and beltless pants/ belts can only be brown or black – no colored belts. Blue jeans or black jeans (no colored jeans) can be worn only with a uniform polo or Craigmont t-shirt/polo. Black, Maroon, Gray or Craigmont sweat/warm up pants can be worn with uniform or Craigmont top/shirt.

Tops - White, Maroon, Black or Gray Polo Shirts; all shirts must have collars; no t-shirts (unless it is a Craigmont t-shirt), under shirts, muscle shirts, sheer or see-through shirts/blouses. No flip flops or pool shoes – all shoes must have a strap.

Dresses – No dresses of any color are allowed.

SCHOOL POLICIES

CELL PHONE Craigmont HS students are allowed to responsibly use their cell phones during lunch and during the 10- minute transition time between classes. However, before they enter a classroom, students must power their cell phones off and put them completely away. If students take their cell phones out during class (without the teacher's permission), they will be asked to turn in their phones. If a cell phone is confiscated, a parent only can pick up the cell phone after 2:30 p.m. the next day. NO phones will be returned during school hours under no circumstances. If a child refuses to turn in their phone, they will receive a 3-day suspension.

TARDIES – School begins at 7:15 a.m. Students should be seated in their first class of the day period class. The cafeteria will open at 6:45 a.m. Any student who has excessive tardies to 1st or 2nd period will be issued an Overnight Suspension. While Overnight Suspensions do not become a part of the child's discipline record, it does give the administration and the parent an opportunity to conference concerning the child's attendance. If the child comes to school without a parent to clear the Overnight Suspension, then then that child is trespassing and could receive a 3-day suspension.
