COLLEGE VISITS- ON CAMPUS

- Announced thorough Spartan Communication
- Publicized on the school website
- Posted outside the Junior and Senior English teachers' classrooms
- Juniors and Seniors can pick up a form from Mrs. Fleming, Mrs. Heaston, and Mr. Waller prior to the meeting
- Must have teacher's permission to attend the meeting during that class period
- Present the signed permission form at the meeting

COLLEGE VISITS- OFF CAMPUS

- Seniors have two-excused absences in the Fall
- Complete a WSHS College Visitation Form before the visit:
 - Forms can be picked up from Mrs. Fleming or Mrs. Heaston
 - Forms must be completed before the visit and turned into Mrs. Schusster-Student Services Office
 - Proof of attendance must be obtained from the college/university and turned into Mrs. Schusster within three days of returning to school. The absence will not count against 1st semester exemptions

TN PROMISE SCHOLARSHIP

- TN PROMISE
 - Two-year scholarship for community college or trade school with no GPA or ACT requirement
 - Application deadline is November 3, 2025 (no exceptions)
 - Must attend one meeting– December 3, 2025, during school
 - Complete 8 hours of community service
 - Complete the FAFSA

TN HOPE/LOTTERY SCHOLARSHIP

Four-year scholarship to any Tennessee school worth \$16,000 over four years

Requires a 3.00 (unweighted) GPA or a 21 on the ACT

Complete the FAFSA and select at least one TN school to receive your information

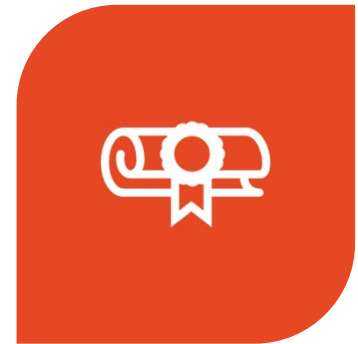

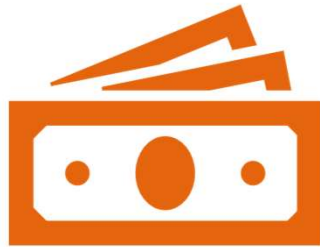
COMMON APPLICATION

- A free online application platform that allows students to apply to multiple colleges at once
- Tracking documents and deadlines: The Common App dashboard helps students keep track of application documents and deadlines.
- Researching financial aid: Students can use the Common App to research financial aid and scholarships.
- Secondary school report– Counselor will need a minimum of two weeks' notice, parent letter, student letter, and resume
- Request ONLY TWO teachers for recommendations

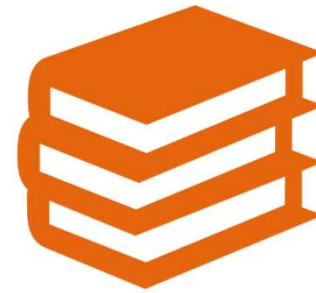
COMMON BLACK APPLICATION

School Links for Students:

1. Log into Clever
2. Scroll to the bottom of the home page and click School Links (also add as favorites)
3. Click Let's Go
4. Answer all the questions: Personality, Career Cluster, Career, Major
5. From the Orange Dashboard Page- select Colleges on the far-right corner
6. Click College App Manager
7. Click Let's Go
8. Complete
 - a. Personal Information- change email from school email to personal email
 - b. Fee Waiver
 - c. FERPA

10. **If you are not using common application**, and just want your transcript submitted to your colleges/universities:
 - a. Add Application- blue button top right corner
 - b. Search colleges and click add colleges
