An assurance that their child's name, address, and telephone listing not be released to military recruiters

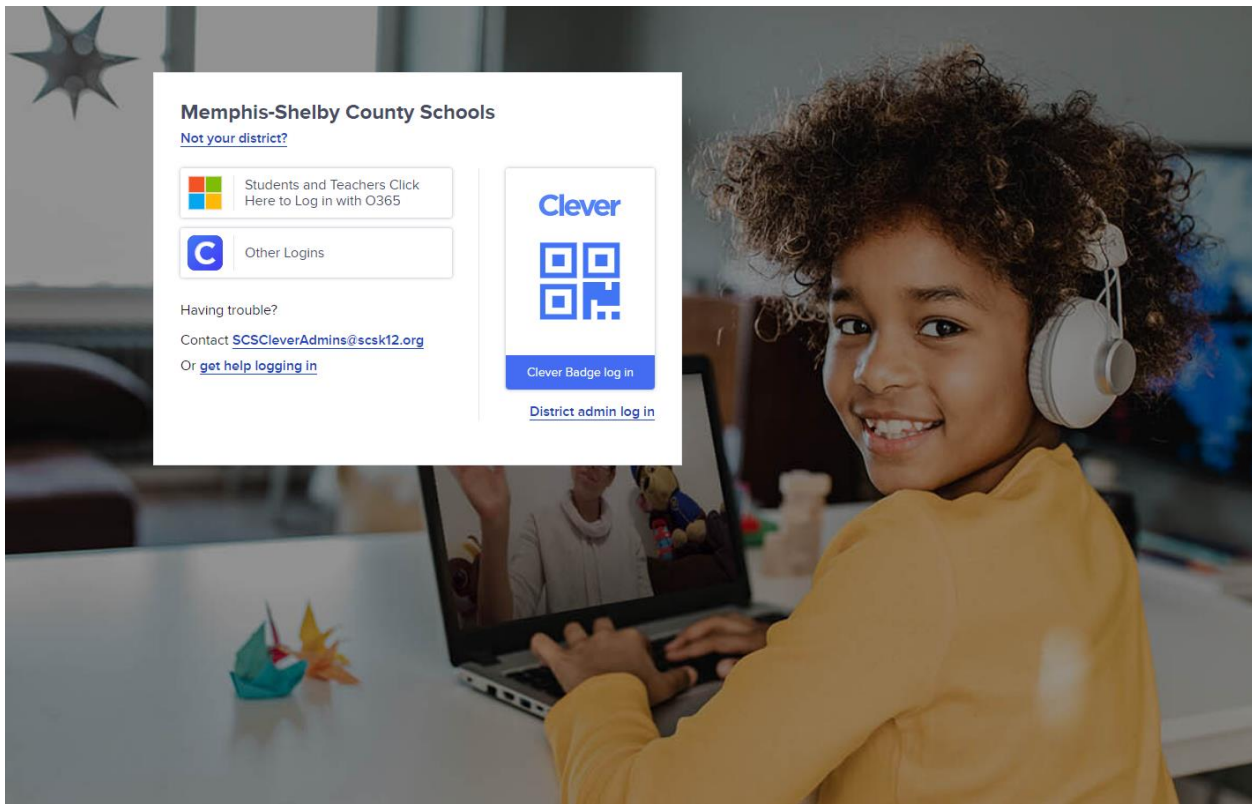

# INTERVENTION

- Intervention will be held daily for all Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 students enrolled at Oakshire Elementary School.
- Additional small group instruction will be provided for students previously identified as Tier 2 and Tier 3 in Literacy and Math.



## ACCESSING INTERVENTION

All students will access the i-Ready Platform by way of Clever.

For the username, type in the student number, which is your child's lunch number.

The password is the student's birthday (2 digits for the month, 2 digits for the day, and 4 digits for the year).  
For example: August 05, 2001 would be entered 08052001

- i-Ready Diagnostic Assessment will serve as the Universal Screener for Grades K-8.
- i-Ready will be used for 'Benchmark Assessments' for ALL grades.

# AIMSWEBPLUS



- aimswebPLUS will be used for RTI<sup>2</sup> Progress Monitoring.

# TCAP/TNREADY

- TCAP/TNReady will be administered between Apr. 14 - May 2, 2025
- *TNREADY Testing.*
- Students in grades 3-8 take the following exams each year: (2<sup>nd</sup> Grade ELA and Math)
  - English/Language Arts
  - Math
  - Science
  - Social Studies
- TNREADY practice questions will be available to parents online in the coming months. Continue to check **TNReady.gov** for more information.

Test items will include:

Multiple choice, evidence-based selected response, multiple select, writing prompt, and editing tasks

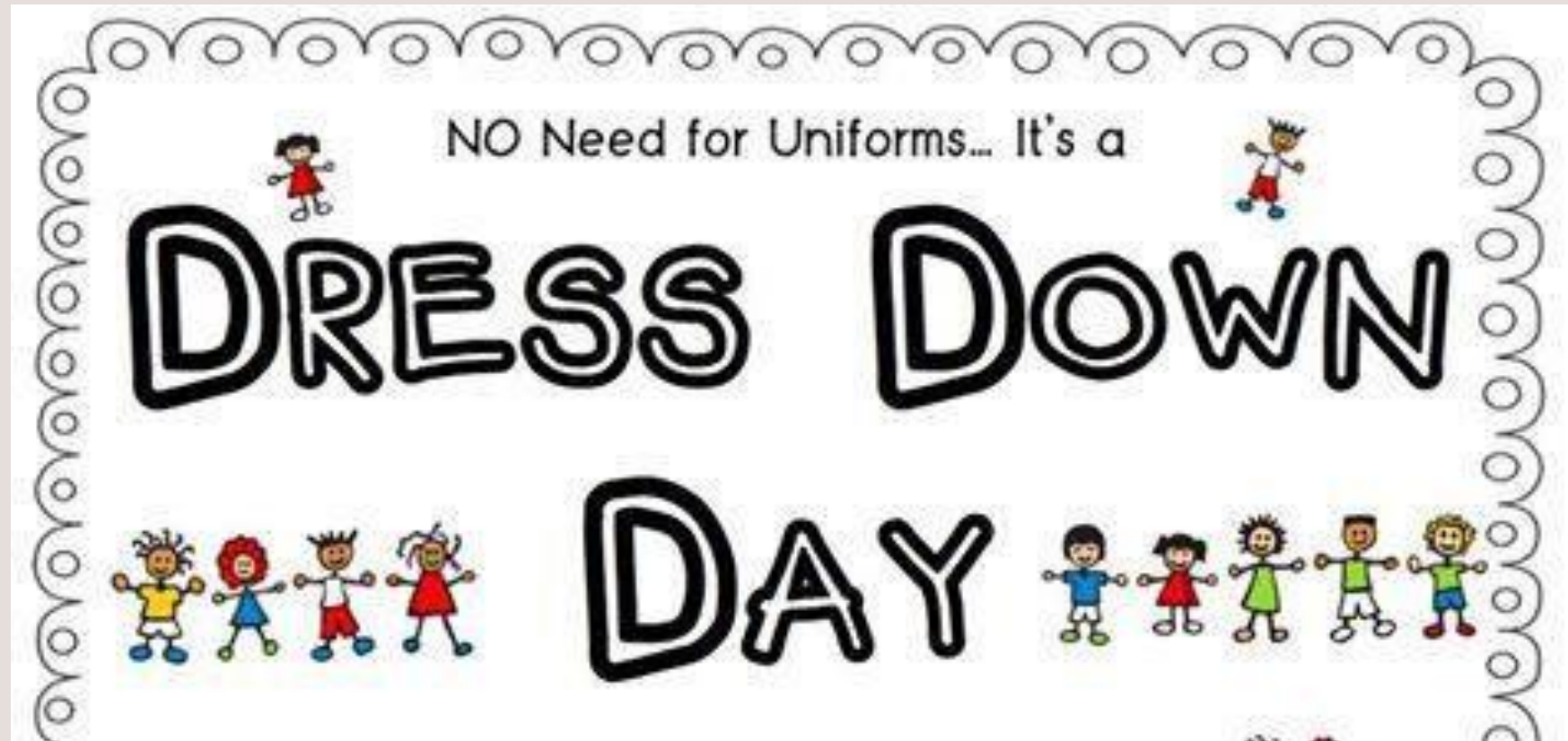
