Advanced Placement Application



An Early Post-Secondary Opportunity (or EPSO) is a high school course or program that allows a student to gain college credit or industry certification. Advanced Placement courses offered by College Board falls under that umbrella. These courses reflect what is being taught at a top-level introductory college course. AP classes are designed to give the feel of a college-level class, both in environment and content. Each AP course has an AP exam, which is given nationwide, for students to earn college credit for that course. Students at Central have an opportunity to select from 19 different courses.

Students must complete the following process to be considered for a course:

1. Complete and submit your application by March 11st to the designated teacher.
2. 2 Teacher Recommendation Forms from a core teacher (English, Math, Science, or Social Studies)
3. Additional items may be required for submission (see Advanced Academics Handbook for additional requirements)

Important Information:

- ✓ All Advanced Placement students at Central are required to take the AP Exam for each registered course.
- ✓ If selected for an AP Course, the student will not be allowed to drop the course after June 30, 2022.
