

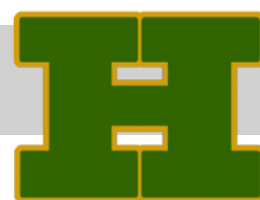
# EARLY POST SECONDARY OPPORTUNITIES
