





- English 9: Regular or Honors
- English 10: Regular, Honors, or Pre-AP

♦ Mathematics: 4 credits

Students are required by state guidelines to enroll in a math course during all four years of high school.

- Algebra I: Regular or Honors
- Geometry: Regular or Honors
- Algebra II: Regular or Honors
- a fourth higher level math course

♦ Science: 3 credits

- Biology I: Regular or Honors
- Chemistry OR Physics: Regular or Honors
- A third lab science

♦ Social Studies: 3.5 credits

- World History & Geography: Regular or Honors OR AP Human Geography
- U.S. History & Geography: Regular, Honors, or AP
- Economics & U.S Government (.5 credit each): Regular, Honors or AP
- ♦ Personal Finance: .5 credits
- ♦ Fine Arts: Music, Theatre Arts, OR Visual Arts
- ♦ Foreign Languages: 2 credits in the same foreign language

♦ Physical Education: 1.5 credits

- Lifetime Wellness (1 credit)

COMMON APP

THE COMMON APPLICATION, WHICH IS ACCEPTED BY MORE THAN 900 SCHOOLS, INCLUDING SOME COLLEGES LOCATED OUTSIDE THE U.S., ALLOWS STUDENTS TO APPLY TO MULTIPLE COLLEGES AT ONCE.

STUDENTS ONLY HAVE TO FILL OUT DETAILS THAT MOST SCHOOLS REQUIRE, INCLUDING NAME, ADDRESS, PARENTAL EMPLOYMENT AND EDUCATION AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, ONE TIME.

YOU STILL HAVE TO PAY THE APPLICATION FEES TO EVERY SCHOOL UNLESS YOU REQUEST A FEE WAIVER
