PEABODY DRESS CODE

Peabody Elementary has adopted the following uniform dress code for all our students:

<u>Boys</u>

Tan, Navy, Black pants or shorts

White, light blue, Peabody blue, navy dress shirt with collar

<u>Girls</u>

Tan, Navy, Black pants, shorts, skirts, or dresses White, light blue, Peabody blue, navy blue blouse with collar

Please remember that shorts/skirts may not be more than 4 inches above the knee.

Light jackets, cardigans, sweaters, or vests may be worn; however, they must be white, light blue, Peabody blue, navy, black, or gray- *WITHOUT PRINTS OR LOGOS*. Heavy coats may NOT be worn during the school day according to MSCS Policy. NO denim material may be worn. T-shirts worn underneath a shirt should be white. Peabody club or spirit T-shirts (Purchased from PTA, After School care, or Peabody) can be worn on Friday with uniform bottoms.
