Date	Task Due	Important Notes
Feb 7	Science Fair packets are introduced to/sent home with students	
Feb 10	Grades K-2 Think of possible topics as a class. Grades 3-5 Students have chosen to work individually or in a group and should have communicated that arrangement to their homeroom/science teacher.	
Feb 13	All Grades Turn in their topic and materials list	Grades 3-5 Students will turn in their packet with these portions (topic/materials list) completed for a grade.
Feb 17	All Grades Background Research Plan, Experiment Plan, and Hypothesis are due	Grades 3-5 Everyone participating in a project should have two websites and two books that they are using for research.
Feb 24	All Grades Analyzing Results portion of packet is due	
March 1	Projects Due Date of Schoolwide Science Fair Date of vote for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners	
March 1	Winning projects taped on FLIP and submitted to District Science Fair	
March 8	District Wide Science Fair	The winning projects from Peabody will be entered into this fair via FLIP
