


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What is Title I ?

Title I is a federal program which provides additional funds above and beyond the funds provided to every Memphis Shelby County school.

Funds are provided to schools who have a certain percentage of socio-economic disadvantaged students. Fox Meadows Elementary School is qualified to receive these federal funds.



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What is Title I ?

Title I serves to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.



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Title One

- Title 1 provides funding to assist in increasing parental involvement. (monthly parent meetings and trainings,)
- Title 1 provides funding to assist and support the instructional program by purchasing instructional supplies. However, supplanting is not allowed.
- Title 1 provides funding to support Professional Development. Redelivery of PD information is required once professional development has been completed.

FAMILY ENGAGEMENT PLAN

Fox Meadows Elementary School's Expectations for Parental Involvement

Fox Meadows Elementary School encourages parental involvement through the following strategies:

- Parents are provided a Family Instructional Resource Center and Parents' Library in the school which provides instructional materials for help at home.

ESSA Involvement

1. Parents are invited to an annual meeting held during and after school to inform parents about the Title I program requirements, school participation in Title I and parental rights to be involved. 6. Parents visit the classrooms and attend after school extra-curricular activities.
7. To communicate and keep parents informed in a timely manner, Fox Meadows Elementary conducts a Meet and Greet for parents (handbooks, Compact, policies), Family Reading Night, Parent-Teacher Conference Days, holiday and special interest programs, monthly school calendar and activities, letters, flyers, newsletters, progress reports notices to describe and explain the curriculum, forms of assessment, and proficiency levels students are expected to meet.

PLAN DE PARTICIPACION FAMILIAR

La Escuela Primaria Fox Meadows creo que se debe alentar a todos los padres a comunicarse, participar y complementar los esfuerzos de instrucción de los maestros. Este Plan de participación de los padres se desarrolló en conjunto con los padres para establecer las expectativas de participación de los padres.

Expectativas de la Escuela Primaria Fox Meadows para la Participación de los Padres

La Escuela Primaria Fox Meadows fomenta la participación de los padres a través de las siguientes estrategias:

Participación ESSA

Los padres también cuentan con un período de preguntas y respuestas para la discusión, y un formulario de evaluación para sugerencias durante cada reunión.
2. 7. Para comunicar y mantener informados a los padres de manera oportuna, la Escuela Primaria Fox Meadows lleva a cabo un Encuentro y Saludo para los padres (manuales, convenio, políticas), Noche de Lectura Familiar, Días de Conferencia de Padres y Maestros, feriados y programas de interés especial, calendario escolar mensual y actividades, cartas, volantes, boletines, informes de progreso, avisos para describir y explicar el plan de estudios, las formas de evaluación y los niveles de competencia que se espera que alcanzen los estudiantes.

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Important Attendance Reminders



Late Arrivals/Early Dismissals

Can have a negative impact on your child's daily academic progress which includes:

- Classroom participation
- Classroom Assignments
- Weekly Assessments/Quizzes
- Growth & Achievement (TNReady)

Chronic Absenteeism

A student is chronically absent if they miss 10 percent or more instructional days in a school year regardless of the reason **(excused or unexcused)**.

- Parents are notified by the Attendance Liaison.
- Attendance data is pulled bi-weekly and reported to Central Office.

Truancy

Any student that has **five or more** unexcused absences is categorized as truant.

- Students are at high risk of being withdrawn if they are truant.
