Monday

Wednesday

3. Practice counting from 1 to 20. Go further if you can!

1. Make a set of nine objects using things you find around your home.
2. What did you learn about balls? Draw and write about it!
3. Practice identifying all the letters of the alphabet.
4. Recite this week's nursery rhyme (found below).
