Remember: <u>PRINT Before</u> you click 'start again' or data will be lost.

Brigance Inventory III Scale for Composite Scores

Students' whose <u>Total Development Composite score</u> falls in the "average range and above," is within the desirable range. The goal is to show growth/progress with each assessment period.

The **Age Equivalent Score** is another valuable data point that provides the child's performance range on the assessment, relative to his/her chronological age.

**Please note that all scores are intended to <u>guide instructional practices and</u> are not to be used in isolation for diagnostic or placement decisions. Other assessments & observations (i.e. Anecdotal notes, Screens, eDECA, & Report Cards) should be used <u>collectively</u> for those purposes.

*<u>Note</u>: Be mindful when recording scores in **section** <u>C</u>. Some skills are <u>not</u> recorded in chronological order.
