The prosperity of any organization depends on the commitment of its membership to work tirelessly towards the goal of excellence, no matter how exhausting the challenge.

Though absolute perfection may never be attained, persistence in attempting to reach perfection is what strengthens us, and our commitments to each other.

The dedication of every band member towards reaching our goals as a team is the most critical element of our success.

The Germantown High School Band Program is dedicated to guiding its students to reach their highest level of excellence. The ultimate goal is to instill a life-long appreciation and love for music.

The Varsity Wind Symphony and the Intermediate Concert Band are the foundation of the band program at Germantown High School. Although we provide many different opportunities for music performance, these ensembles provide the full range of music education from which other opportunities stem. This is where fundamentals are taught and musicianship flourishes.

Although performance is a major goal for our courses, it is not the only one. It is our belief that "the process is just as important as the product." Most musical concepts are taught through the rehearsal of quality literature for performance. There are standards, however, that are not met through performance. Student objectives include listening to, discussing, and writing about music as well as acquiring a basic knowledge of music history and theory.

All students are encouraged to participate in as many musical opportunities as they can both through and outside of Germantown High School. *Private lessons are strongly recommended*. If a student is interested in continuing with music beyond high school, private lessons and involvement in as many musical opportunities as possible are essential for success.

ENSEMBLES

VARSITY WIND SYMPHONY: This is the *premier* performance ensemble of the band program. This ensemble is designed for *advanced musicians* with emphasis placed on the musicianship skills required for performance of sophisticated literature grade IV and above. *Members are required to audition for the All-West Band*. Performances include concerts, performance assessments, festivals, and music conferences. After-school rehearsal time is required. Members must also participate in the Marching Band. Members of this group should be enrolled in Sr. Band Advanced (Honors) I, II, III, or IV. *Private lessons strongly recommended and expected of experienced players*.

INTERMEDIATE CONCERT BAND: This ensemble is designed to develop the necessary skills needed to display intermediate level musicianship capabilities. Members of the Intermediate Band are not required to audition for the All-West Band. These groups strive for excellence by performing in concerts, performance assessments, and festivals. After school rehearsals are mandatory. Members must participate in the Marching Band. Members of this group should be enrolled in Sr. Band I, II, III, or IV. Private lessons are strongly recommended.


MARCHING BAND: The Germantown Red Devils Marching Band operates primarily during the fall and is comprised of the Varsity Band, Intermediate Band, and Color Guard. Basics of marching and playing in an outdoor ensemble setting are the primary points of emphasis. Performances include football games, performance assessments, festivals, and parades. This band rehearses after school *daily*. Instrumentalists of this group should be enrolled in Sr. Band I; Sr. Band Honors I, II, III, IV; or Senior Band Advanced Honors I, II, III, or IV, Percussion I, II, III, or IV, or Honors Percussion I, II, III, or IV.

JAZZ BAND: This class is designed for musicians interested in learning elements of jazz music. Emphasis is placed on the development of swing, blues, modern jazz, and Latin styles of repertoire for performance. Members are required to audition for the All-West Band. Performances include concerts, performance assessments, festivals, and music conferences. No prior experience in jazz is required, and all GHS students are welcomed to join. *Students are strongly encouraged to take advantage of lesson provided through our partnership with the Memphis Jazz Workshop*. Instrumentalists of this group must be enrolled in Honors (Jazz) Stage Band I, II, III, IV.

PERCUSSION ENSEMBLE: Better known as the *GrooveHouse Drumline*. This group of student-musicians operates both within (football season) and independently (battle season) of the Red Devil Marching Band. Emphasis is placed on the development of rudimentary skills, mallets percussion, and drum line performance. Instrumentalists of this group should be enrolled in one of our available percussion classes. This ensemble performs year-round, with the bulk of its independent competitive work (rehearsals and performances) occurring in the spring semester.

WINTER GUARD: This is our indoor color guard. Winter Guard is a competitive, performance-based activity which incorporates choreographed staging, dance, and manipulation of equipment such as flags, prop rifles, and sabers. Unlike traditional color guard, winter guard operates independently of any band ensemble, so any students may participate. The winter guard season generally runs from December through Spring Break. There is a separate fee associated with participation.

Student Communication Cycle:

The Drum Major(s) sits atop the student communication hierarchy. They are the direct link between students and band staff and are the primary source for student information.

Section leaders and captains are responsible for managing section materials, running efficient sectional rehearsals, and maintaining communication within the section and to the drum major (s). This communication includes, but is not limited to, attendance, conflict resolution, and general support with section members.

The "ask three before me (director)" concept helps this cycle of communication function properly and helps build a trustworthy community among band peers. If a student has a question, they should first ask the closest section member, then ask a section, leader, next ask a drum major. The answer is always somewhere within your student communication cycle.

Please note that these cycles of communication do not suggest that the band director will not talk to students or parents on an individual basis. This is in place to make sure that the director has adequate time to commit to the larger tasks that impact all students and parents.

Parent Communication Cycle:

The Parent Booster Club President sits atop the parent communication hierarchy. This person is the direct link between parents and band staff and are the primary source for reporting and disseminating pertinent parent information.

The Booster Board is comprised of the president, vice president, secretary, and treasurer. The board manages several aspects of the band program that primarily include communication to all parents, collecting band fees, fundraising, and assisting committees with creating and maintaining adequate opportunities for parent volunteerism.

Parent Committees are sub-groups of parents that support the board and band staff with implementing the vision of the director and meeting the needs of students (travel & equipment and hospitality & concessions are our biggest areas where parent volunteers are needed.

The "ask three before me (director)" concept helps this cycle of communication function properly and helps build a trustworthy community among band parents. The answer is always somewhere within your parent communication cycle.

The purpose of this agreement is to provide you with an overview of the costs involved in participating as a member of the Germantown High School Band. All Band Fees support the GHS Band Programs for the entire academic year. Without your financial contributions, our award-winning program could not function.

Band fees for the school year are \$500.00 for all participants. Fees should be paid in full before the last Friday, September 20, 2024 (no extensions). Not including color quard members, siblings' fees are \$400.00.

Your signature on this agreement is your commitment to participate in the GHS Band for the entire school year. Please be certain that you understand all your responsibilities before signing. A parent/legal guardian must co-sign this agreement.

Financial obligations for the members of the Germantown High School Red Devil Band are as follows:

- 4. First Payment of \$250.00
