August

January

- Some colleges require midyear reports. If so, complete the now.
- If you plan to stay on campus, start reviewing student housing.
- Check your GPA for Hope Scholarship eligibility
- Your class rank will be calculated

September

- Jostens Presentation for senior memorabilia.
- Start college applications or speak with a military recruiter
- Submit transcripts for applied colleges
- Check the forms for your college applications to determine what is needed to complete admissions. If a recommendation is need, contact teacher/counselor immediately. Please allow 2 weeks to complete.
- Create a Fastweb account at <u>www.fastweb.com</u> and <u>www.scholarships.com</u>

February

- The FAFSA application opens. Complete the FAFSA ASAP.
- All males 18 years old must register for the Selective Service https://www.sss.gov/register/
- Most college/university scholarships are due Feb. 1.

October

- If you are an athlete planning to play for a Division I or II college, apply to the NCAA Eligibility Center online at https://web3.ncaa.org/ecwr3/
- Have your parents complete the FAFSA to apply for Financial Aid at www.fafsa.gov
- Have your parents attend FAFSA Night on October 26th
- State ACT for Seniors

March/April

- College acceptance letters and Financial Aid offers should start arriving via email or college portal.
- Continue applying for scholarships.
- Narrow your college acceptance to 3 colleges to make a decision.
- If you plan to stay on campus, pay housing fee.
- Inform college of your decision to attend for the Fall.
- Prepare for final exams. These grade will count toward college admission and HOPE scholarship.
- Deadline for Recommendation Letter from Ms. Norman

November

- Continue completing your college applications and/or speaking with military recruiter.
- Continue searching for scholarships and Financial Aid opportunities
- Attend 1st Mandatory TN Promise Meeting

May

- May 1st is decision day. Accept your college offer to attend and finalize financial aid.
- Register for Freshman Orientation.
- Request to send FINAL transcript from GHS to college choice.

December

- Complete and submit applications to 1 Safety college and 2Match colleges.
- Study for 1st Semester Exams. Your GPA will be recalculated in January for class ranking.
- Retake ACT by registering for February test date.
