What Needs to Be Included in Your Presentation!

- 5 Qualities or Facts about the instrument family
- A brief history on your instrument family
- How your instrument family makes sound (for example: a percussion instrument makes sounds by either striking, shaking or scraping the instrument)
- 4 Common instruments in your family

Qué incluir en tu presentación

- 5 Cualidades o datos sobre la familia de instrumentos
- Una breve historia de su familia de instrumentos
- Cómo produce sonido su familia de instrumentos (por ejemplo: un instrumento de percusión produce sonidos cuando se golpea, se sacude o se raspa)
- 4 instrumentos comunes en tu familia

While working in your groups to research, prepare with your group on who will be doing the speaking for your presentation!
