


MUSIC V. NOISE


MUSIC

Melody, harmony, or rhythm

NOISE








INSTRUMENTS.




* TRADITIONAL V. NON-TRADITIONAL INSTRUMENTS

TRADITIONAL

- Any instrument created for the purpose of making music!

NON-TRADITIONAL

- Anything **NOT** created for music, but it being used as such.



FINAL CONCEPT:

Pitched v. unpitched instruments



* PITCHED

- + A pitched instrument is any instrument that has a pitch you can hum back
 - × Examples: piano, flute, violin, cello, trumpet, saxophone etc.



* UNPITCHED

- + Any instrument that does NOT have a pitch you can hum back.
- + Examples: drums, bongos, cowbell, tambourine, cymbals etc.


