Attendance/Tardy Policy

Tardies

If a student is late for the same class 3xs in the same week and/or 4xs in a two-day period with different classes, the student will receive the following consequences below.

- 1st Offense: 2 Days of In School Suspension
- 2nd Offense: 3 Days of In School Suspension
- 3rd Offense: 1 Day of Out of School Suspension (General Choice Revoke = 9 to 12 tardies)
- 4th Offense: 2 Days of Out of School Suspension
- 5th Offense: 5 Days of Out of School Suspension
- 6th Offense: Recommendation for expulsion

Unexcused Absence/Class Cutting

If a student is absent from class due to class cutting (unexcused absence), the student will receive the following consequences below.

- 1st Offense- 2 Days of In School Suspension
- 2nd Offense-3 Days of In School Suspension
- 3rd Offense- 1 Day of Out of School Suspension (General Choice Revoke= 9 to 12 absences)
- 4th Offense- 2 Days of Out of School Suspension
- 5th Offense-5 Days of Out of School Suspension
- 6th Offense- Recommendation for expulsion

General Choice Transfer Revoke

If the student receives a combination of 3 In School Suspensions and/or 3 Out of School Suspensions, the student's general choice status will be revoked at the end of the semester.

Examples: 2nd Offense in ISS Tardies + 1 ISS for Cell Phone Violation = Transfer Revoke.

1 ISS for Disruptive/Disrespectful Behavior + 1st Offense in ISS for Tardies + 1st Offense in ISS for Class cutting = Transfer Revoke.

Student reaches 3rd Offense and/or has 10 or more tardies or absences=Transfer Revoke.

Attendance and Academics are Related

Fact #1: Students who do not attend class regularly (This includes being on time). Do not do well academically.

Fact #2: Students who struggle academically but attend class regularly will have more favorable options than students who do not attend class regularly or are consistently tardy.

Fact #3: Class cutting consequences are worse than tardy consequences. Why? You will be in ISS for 2 to 3 Days and miss 2 to 3 Days of classes.
