



NAME THAT PRESIDENT

Your child has been assigned the president, _____, for our next project. Your child has brought home the book needed to prepare a quality product. Please help your child find the information, but have him/her draw, color, decorate, and write by himself/herself. Your child must do all of the written work to complete the project in order to get credit. *Work submitted late or that isn't done by the child will be graded as such and reflected in the social studies grade for the report card.

Your child must write, "**Name That President**" on the front of the 1st white page. This should be the only thing written or visible on the 1st white page (the cover). Have your child write his/her name on the back. Then include the following information in this order:

Pg. 2. The name and outline of the state the president was from along with a sentence (*I was from ____.*)

Pg. 3. A sentence stating the political party of the president (*I was a member of the ____ party.*)

Pg. 4 Draw/write an interesting fact about the president [(ex. coin/bill on which you find his picture, famous quote, notable achievements, pets, etc.) *I am on the ____ or I said, "____."*]

Pg. 5. Write a sentence stating what # president he was (*I was the 1st president.*)

Pg. 6 Write, "*Who am I with the initials ____.*" (complete with president's initials)

Pg. 7. Picture (can be printed) and name of the president (glued on the construction paper and hidden under the white pgs.)

Finally, decorate the front cover (only the red/blue construction paper border) so that it is patriotic and appealing. You can use stars, stickers, glue, etc. BUT **DO NOT PUT THE NAME OR PICTURE OF THE PRESIDENT ANYWHERE ON THE FRONT. THESE THINGS SHOULD ONLY BE SEEN ON PAGE 7.**

* This is a guessing game, so please write the name of the president and put the picture on the construction paper under the last white piece of paper.

** Your child will be presenting the information to the class and to the visitors during International Festival. Please rehearse all the information with your child so he/she will be confident when presenting.
