# Whitehaven High School Family Engagement Plan



Whitehaven High School encourages on-going parental involvement in the educational process. We have jointly developed with our parents a written Family Engagement Plan. The School Level Family Engagement Plan has established the expectations for parent involvement. We share a common goal of promoting success in every child on a daily basis. We will do the following:

1. Convene annual meetings at flexible times where all parents are invited, informed of Title I requirements, school's participation in Title I, and the right of parents to be involved in the school. Meetings will be held in the morning and evening.
2. Provide, describe, and explain with parents the curriculum, academic assessment and proficiency level of every child making them aware of a Parents' Right to Know.
3. Provide timely information about programs under parental involvement.
4. Provide opportunities for regular parent meetings to keep parents informed of Whitehaven's activities and progress, as well as invite feedback from parents.
5. Develop jointly with parents a school/parent compact.
6. Encourage parents to share in the decision-making process by participating in Whitehaven's Leadership Council and Parent Teacher Student Organization (PTSO).
7. Encourage parental participation in academic and extra/co-curricular activities.
8. Involve parents in an organized, ongoing and timely way, in the planning, review and improvement of programs for parental involvement and the School Level Family Engagement Plan.
9. Involve parents in the annual planning and development of the Tennessee School Improvement Plan.
10. Schedule a flexible number of meetings; hold parent conferences and mail out hard copies of student's curriculum/academic progress reports and report cards to inform parents of student academic progress.
11. Provide alternate means of communication to provide information (Flyer, newsletter, school website, School Messenger).
12. Sponsor a variety of workshops for parents to ensure they have an opportunity to participate in the development of their child's educational programs.

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
